## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to provide staff with guidance in counseling and administering retirement benefits for System members in a deferred vested status.

## **POLICY**

- Pursuant to the Fresno Municipal Code, ultimately it is the member's responsibility to inform the Retirement System, in writing, when he/she reaches an age eligible for retirement and wishes to begin receiving retirement benefits.
- Distribution of retirement benefits begins upon submission of a retirement application and eligibility of the member to receive retirement benefits. There is no retroactivity of retirement benefits.
- It is the member's responsibility to inform the Retirement Office of his/her current mailing address.

## **PROCEDURES**

- At separation from City service, Retirement staff will advise the deferred vested member of the Boards' policy items listed above.
- Approximately six months before a deferred vested member reaches full retirement age, retirement staff will attempt to notice the member requesting that he/she contact the Retirement Office to complete elections and documents to begin distribution of retirement benefits.
